



To find out your collection dates and locate a recycling centre, download the Recycle! app free of charge.

Tips for curbside collections:



Leave your waste outside at the times shown on your waste collection calendar.



In snow or icy conditions, the waste collection vehicles may be unable to guarantee collection. In this case, please take your rubbish back in and put it out again on the next date when that type of waste is due to be collected.



Do not use plastic containers to put out your communal bags, organic waste bags, or paper-cardboard. We cannot be held responsible if they are damaged during collection.



Leave your microchipped bin or residual waste bag, paper and cardboard, PMD and organic bags in a clearly visible, accessible position in a public area at the edge of the road, without obstructing the footpath, making sure they are accessible. Do not leave them in the gutter when it is raining.



The maximum authorised weight for bags and boxes is 15 kg.

Anything heavier will not be collected.



If your residual waste is collected in colour-coded bags, wrap sharp objects in newspaper to prevent injury to the waste collection operative.

Reduce your waste:



Buy products with less packaging.



Put a "Stop Pub" sticker on your letterbox to reduce junk mail.



Go for second hand.



Don't waste food.
